














Who are the TechSteppers?



#### WHO WE ARE

- Volunteers on the OIAA TechSteppers ad hoc Committee
- Individuals with a wide array of technical skills and experience
- A committee that, to the best of our abilities, adheres to the 36 Principals of Alcoholics Anonymous.

#### WHAT WAS THE NEED?

- Data showed an increase in de-listings.
- Reaching out revealed groups with limited access to, or experience with, support for Zoom meeting settings.
- We heard from OIAA members who were willing and able to share their experiences.



#### **OUR OBJECTIVES**

- To help Zoom meeting account holders and groups provide safer and more welcoming online AA meetings by sharing our experiences with Zoom meeting settings and practices.
- To help individuals and groups overcome technical challenges and access online AA meetings.



#### **OUR OBJECTIVES**

To acquire and disseminate technical resources to benefit the OIAA and the online AA groups we serve.



#### WHAT WE DO

- Receive incoming requests for support. Each request is "claimed" by a TechStepper.
- Reach out to the person requesting support to determine if and how we can assist them in overcoming their obstacles.



#### WHAT WE DO

- Meet with the person requesting support, the Zoom account holder, and/or the Group's Conscience to share our experiences with similar obstacles.
- Document our experience as an ongoing resource
